





RSAMCC Merit Awards 2022-2023

Applications are now open DEADLINE TO APPLY: February 26, 2023 9pm



The Redstone Arsenal Military and Civilians' Club (RSAMCC) will be awarding educational merit awards in 2023 to eligible students who are affiliated with and acting as contributing members of the Redstone Arsenal, Alabama, military and government civilian community.

There are two types of scholarships for 2022-2023. Eligibility requirements and the application can be found at www.rsamcc.org/merit-awards Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

RSAMCC Merit Award For members of RSAMCC and their dependents.

Military Community Scholarship 2022-2023

Please read eligibility requirements in the form. Applicants do NOT need to be a member of the RSAMCC Club to be eligible.



RSAMCC Merit Award Requirements:

Merit Awards eligibility is open to the following: graduating high school seniors of the Class of 2023 who plan to continue their education, currently enrolled full-time college students, and military spouses enrolled in college (full- or part-time).

The Applicant must meet all the following criteria:

- Sponsor must be a member of RSAMCC in good standing by December 13, 2022.
- Applicant must not be in receipt of a full scholarship (pays tuition, room or board) or full post 9/11 GI Bill for the upcoming school year to include appointment to military academies for all service branches.
- Be a graduating high school senior attending a high school within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal (with at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale).
- Plan to pursue an Associate's, Bachelor's, or higher-level degree from an accredited college or university for the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Satisfy all limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth in the "Limitations and Conditions" section.

All applicants are eligible for the MOAA Military Community-sponsored scholarships. Applicants being sponsored by an RSAMCC member will have priority for RSAMCC-sponsored scholarships. Deadline to become an RSAMCC member is December 13, 2022.

If you do not meet these eligibility requirements, your application will NOT be considered. Additional proof may be required on a case by case basis. The applicant's sponsor (for spouses) or legal guardian (for children) must share the same home of record with the applicant and belong in one of the above categories.



Military Community Scholarship Requirements:

The Applicant must meet one of the criteria for 1-3 and criteria 4:

- Be a child or grandchild of an HCMOAA member
- Be a legal dependent spouse or child of an Armed Forces member who is: Active Duty and assigned to a Redstone Arsenal unit and resides within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal at the time this application is submitted, OR A Reserve Member and assigned to a Redstone Arsenal unit and resides within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal, OR A National Guard Member and assigned to a Redstone Arsenal unit and resides within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal unit military member residing within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal,
- Participate in a local JROTC program within a 50-mile radius of Redstone Arsenal
- Plan to pursue an Associate's, Bachelor's, or higher-level degree from an accredited college or university for the 2023-2024 academic year. Individuals currently enrolled in a program must possess at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Satisfy all limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth in the "Limitations and Conditions" section.

If you do not meet these eligibility requirements, your application will NOT be considered. Additional proof may be required on a case by case basis. Applicants do NOT need to be a member of the RSAMCC Club to be eligible for the Military Community Scholarship.



LIMITATIONS & CONDITIONS



Restrictions- Applies to ALL Eligibility Categories

- An Applicant must not be a previous awardee of a RSAMCC scholarship.
- RSAMCC reserves the right to determine eligibility and to increase, decrease or withdraw any or all awards.
- Applicants who accept a full four-year tuition/room & board scholarship, a full four-year grant, or an appointment to a military academy will NOT be eligible to receive any RSAMCC scholarship monies. Additionally, any student who receives from a family member a Post 9/11 GI Bill disbursement that covers the entire cost of the yearly tuition/room & board, will NOT be eligible to receive RSAMCC Merit Awards Scholarship monies.
- Recipients must be enrolled or plan to be enrolled in their accredited college or university for the 2023-2024 academic year.
- The number of scholarships awarded and the dollar amount of each scholarship are determined by the success of fundraising endeavors of the RSAMCC and HCMOAA.
- Scholarships presented at the annual RSAMCC Merit Awards banquet must be deposited into the student's school account to be used for the costs of tuition, room and board.

December 1, 2022 - RSAMCC 2023 Merit Awards Applications available online

December 13th, 2022 (before midnight) – Full Year 2022-23 RSAMCC Membership Application Deadline (with dues paid)

February 26, 2023 (before 9pm(CT)) – Completed RSAMCC Merit Award Application Packet Deadline

May 1, 2023 – All applicants will be notified and award recipients will be required to present their eligibility documentation.

TUES, May 16, 2023, 5:30 p.m. - RSAMCC Merit Award Presentation at The Summit on Redstone Arsenal. Applicants are required to be in attendance to receive their award. Any exceptions must be approved by the RSAMCC Merit Award Committee Chair with approval from the RSAMCC Board.

The Redstone Arsenal Military and Civilians' Club (RSAMCC) is a volunteer organization that "salutes" those who have served our country and the DoD civilian community that supports them. We aim to foster good fellowship by providing educational, cultural, and enjoyable activities for our members.

Throughout the year, our organization raises funds that we then give back to our community in a variety of ways. Our Community Assistance Grants are for non-profit organizations that host projects or events that directly support and honor active duty military, veterans, DoD civilians, and their families. We recognize we have an obligation to use our funds wisely, and to ensure that we donate to organizations that reflect our club's values, practice good stewardship, and meet the needs of the local military and DoD civilian community.

WHO CAN APPLY FOR COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE GRANTS:

There are many worthy causes that deserve support and our club funds are limited; therefore, we use the following criteria in making funding decisions:

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

All organizations requesting a Community Assistance Grant must meet the following criteria. If the organization's project/event does not meet these minimum requirements, their funding application will not be considered.

- The organization or group making the request must be non-profit/not-for-profit. Community Assistance Grants are not awarded to individuals or to for-profit businesses.
- The requested funds must be used for a specific project or event that will occur or begin no earlier than July 1, 2023, and conclude no later than June 30, 2024. Please see the Limitations section below for further details.
- The project/event for which funds are being requested must be located within a 50mile radius of Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville, Alabama. The requesting organization hosting the project/event may be headquartered beyond that radius, but the event or project itself must be within 50 miles of the Arsenal.
- The project/event must support, honor, or promote military, veterans, DoD civilians, and/or their families. The requesting organization's overall mission does not have to specifically focus on the military, DoD civilians, or their respective family members, just the project/event for which funds are being requested.

PRIORITY CONSIDERATION:

The RSAMCC Community Assistance Grants selection committee gives priority consideration to projects/events that:

- are projects/events of a registered 501(c) organization;
- meet practical, tangible needs;
- impact multiple people, not just one or a few individuals



LIMITATIONS:

Grant requests will NOT be provided to/for the following:

- Normal operating expenses, including salaries, overhead, office supplies, or advertising.
- Fundraising activities.
- Completed expenditures or events/projects that occurred or concluded prior to July 1, 2023.
- Goods or services that could be obtained using appropriated funds.
- Political parties or activities.

GRANTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED

A reminder that our funds are limited. Organizations that meet all the above criteria will receive higher priority in the selection process, but are not guaranteed to receive a grant (in part or in full) simply because they meet the criteria.

OBLIGATIONS OF GRANT RECIPIENTS:

Funds donated are to be used for the sole purpose for which they were requested and may not be used to fund other needs not identified in the original request.

Funds must be deposited no later than August 31, 2023. If any portion of received funding is no longer needed for the requested purpose, unused funds must be returned to RSAMCC.

Applications will NOT be accepted through mail, but only through our online application form located at rsamcc.org/community-assistance

Completed applications must be submitted and received no later 5:00 p.m. CT on Friday, March 31, 2023, or they will be rejected.

Award recipients will be notified by the end of April.




