From The President

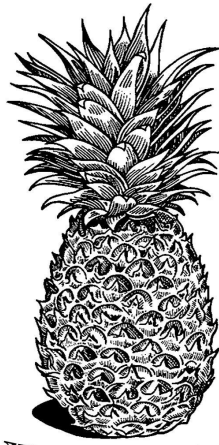


It is with great privilege and honor that I once again greet all of you with a second term as President of the RSAMCC that has a long standing and rooted tradition in serving the military community and all its members.

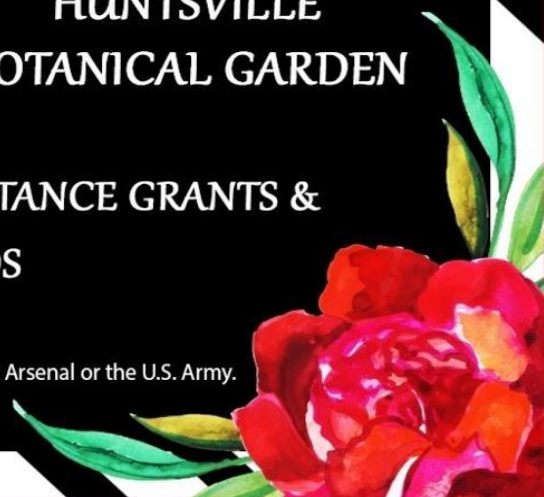
