FUN FACT

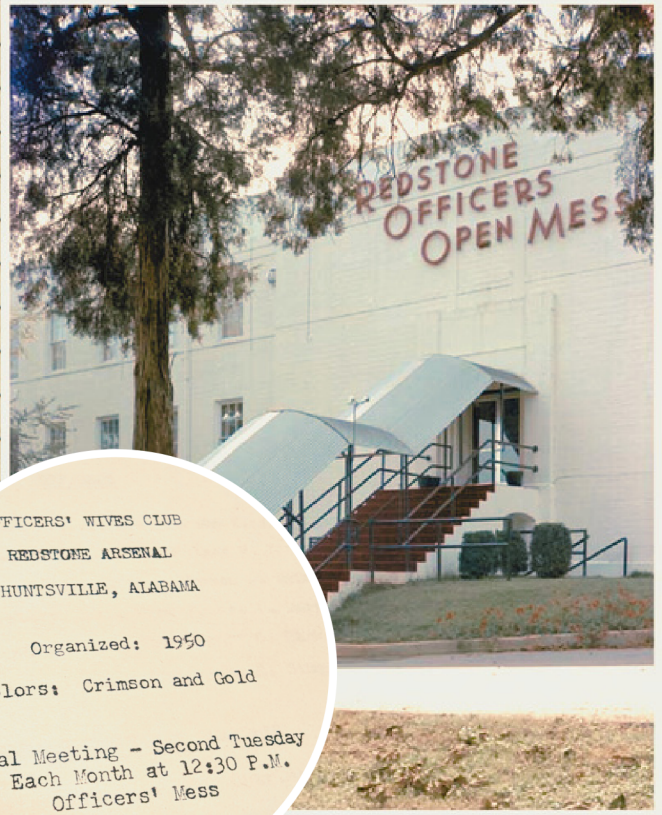
Redstone Arsenal was built and established in 1941 as a chemical manufacturing facility. In the 1950s it became the focal point of the Army's rocket and space projects.



In September of 1951, the club celebrated its first birthday with birthday cake with commanding officer of Redstone Arsenal COL Carroll Hudson.



The Redstone Arsenal Military & Civilians' Club was originally named the Officers Wives Club of Redstone Arsenal and was organized in September of 1950. Dues were \$2.50 every 6 months. They also met the 2nd Tuesday of each month. Just like we still do today. There were 5 committees, one of which was the Friendship Committee which was similar to our current Membership Outreach Committee.

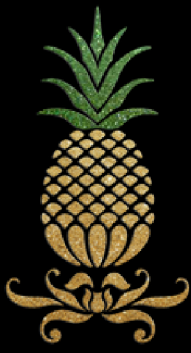
