





X marks the spot! Did you know that on March 11th, 2008 the Redstone Arsenal Officer & Civilians Club (now RSAMCC) buried a Time Capsule next to the left side of the gazebo in front of the Summit. Our very own KC Bertling was the Historian at the time and orchestrated the event. The capsule is due to be opened in 2033, 25 years later. The capsule is an ammo box labeled OCWC and MWR and holds a note from each OCWC board member to their successor, a newspaper article about the club's garden club, MWR information and a copy of that day's Redstone Rocket.



#### Women's club hopes to draw crowd for art auction






