



The table is round

to show our everlasting concern for our fallen and our missing.

The table, set for one

is small, symbolizing the frailty of one prisoner alone against his or her suppressors.

The white tablecloth

symbolizing the purity of their intentions to respond to their country's call to arms.

The single red rose

reminds us of the life of each of our fallen, and the loved ones and friends who miss them each and every day.

The vase is tied with a red ribbon

a symbol of our continued determination to remember our fallen and find our missing.

The slices of lemon

on the plate is to remind us of the bitter fate of those who will never return.

A pinch of salt

symbolizes the tears endured by the friends and families of those who have fallen and of those who have not returned.

The inverted wine glass

they cannot toast with us at this time.

The empty chair

they are no longer with us.

The candle

is reminiscent of the light of hope which lives in our hearts to illuminate their way home from their captors, to the open arms of a grateful nation.







Join us as we Remember and Honor our veterans by laying Remembrance wreaths on the graves of our fallen heroes.


